Goal: To honor and recognize our class of 2020 by providing them a districtwide united event full of positive energy including staff representing every school in the district!

Participants:

- One car per senior will be permitted
 - All participants (including graduates) **must** remain in their vehicles.
- A distinctive sign will be sent to all seniors to identify them and their school
 - This sign will need to be taped to the front passenger-side window in order to be granted access to the parade
- Only SUHSD staff will be permitted to be on the perimeter of the parade route to cheer on the students as they go through
 - **Staff and law enforcement will screen the student credentials upon entrance to the SWCC facility. Staff and law enforcement will provide campus coverage to detect and intervene with any unauthorized foot or vehicular traffic.**

Parade Details:

- All seniors in SUHSD are invited to join this drive-thru celebration parade at SWC on Thursday, June 4, 2020
- This is **not** in lieu of a graduation (in-person graduation ceremony is still pending for the future-possibly July/August), but rather just a small token of acknowledgement districtwide for our graduating seniors
- Each senior is encouraged to decorate their car with their name, school colors, etc. (see sample below...decorations not provided by schools)



Event Health and Safety Protocol:

- **County of San Diego Health Officer Guidelines:** Although the Senior Celebration Parade is not a graduation, SUHSD will adhere to all of the current requirements for drive-through graduations set forth by the County of San Diego Health Officer: all students will stay in their vehicles, there will be no spectators, there will be no food or concession stands, there will be no open restrooms, and only members of the same household are permitted in vehicles.
- **Social Distancing:** All district/school staff and law enforcement will maintain current social distancing protocol set forth in the County of San Diego Health Order.
- **Access Management:** In order to assist law enforcement and staff in regulating and enforcing an orderly vehicular flow as well as a no-spectator policy, students will display their distinctive school sign in the windshield of their vehicle, and all staff will wear school attire and clearly visible official ID. Staff and law enforcement will screen the student credentials upon entrance to the SWCC facility. Staff and law enforcement will provide campus coverage to detect and intervene with any unauthorized foot or vehicular traffic.
